## University of Glamorgan Recommended

**1 1** Crusan Colombard-Sauvignon Blanc, VdP Côtes des Gascogne **£10.25**  
Fresh and fruity from two popular grape varieties noted for producing wines with strong fruity aromas and refreshing acidity. **12% abv**

**2 2** Berri Estates Unoaked Chardonnay, SE Australia **£10.75**  
Fresh and lemony with crisp, ripe acidity and good weight. Fermented and matured in stainless steel with no oak contact to retain the classic Chardonnay varietal fruit. **13.5% abv**

## White Wine

**3 2** Pinot Grigio, Grave del Friuli, Friulvini **£13.95**  
Crisp and fruity with a delightful, spicy, floral aroma. A fine example of this popular Italian varietal grown in north-eastern Italy. **12.5% abv**

**4 1** Nobile Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough **£15.95**  
A rich cocktail of passionfruit, tangerine and ripe peach characters with an underlying hint of grassy complexity and a crisp, dry, lingering finish. **12.5% abv**

**5 2** Kleine Zalze Bush Vines Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch **£11.95**  
Soft and creamy with a hint of tropical fruit flavours on the finish. The marriage of ripe Chenin fruit with a delicious vanilla sweetness from the oak, makes for a most harmonious result. **14% abv**

**6 2** Houghton Private Bin Chardonnay-Verdelho, W Australia **£12.25**  
Wonderfully fresh and fruity, unoaked with ripe fruit characters and a long, clean finish. A soft, fresh and fruity palate with melon and tropical aromas and flavours dominating a long, flavoursome finish. Bottled under screwcap for freshness. **14% abv**

**7 3** Stonehaven Cellar Selection Riesling, Limestone Coast **£12.95**  
Fresh and lively, exhibiting zesty lemon and lime characters, some floral notes and a dry, crisp, fruity balanced finish. Bottled under screwcap for added freshness. **13% abv**



## Rosé Wine

- 8 3** Hardys 'The Riddle' Cabernet-Grenache SE Australia **£10.50**  
Aromas of ripe strawberry with floral, rose petal overtones. Light-bodied on the palate, with soft sweet berry fruit flavours. Best consumed whilst the wine is young and lively. **13.5% abv**

## University of Glamorgan Recommended

- 9 B** Crusan Grenache-Merlot, VdP d'Oc **£10.25**  
A blend of Grenache and Merlot grape varieties producing a lovely soft round wine with fresh fruity flavours. **12% abv**
- 10 C** Berri Estates Shiraz, SE Australia **£10.75**  
Medium-bodied and fruity with blackberry and cherry aromas. Red pepper, coffee and toasted vanilla flavours combine to provide good complexity on the palate. **14% abv**

## Red Wine

- 11 C** Veramonte Merlot, Winemaker's Selection, Casablanca Valley **£13.95**  
Rich and full-bodied from this popular grape, blackberry and cherry aromas and flavours with a touch of mint and oak on the finish. **13.5% abv**
- 12 C** Domaine du Seuil Merlot-Cabernet Sauvignon **£15.95**  
A blend of predominantly Merlot with 40% Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, which helps to provide structure and complexity. Aged for six months in oak barrels. **12.5% abv**
- 13 C** Houghtons Private Bin Cabernet-Shiraz, W Australia **£12.25**  
Elegant with wonderful, dark, ripe, berry fruit flavours, fine tannins and well balanced oak. Bottled under screwcap for added freshness. **14% abv**
- 14 C** Vendange Zinfandel, California **£13.25**  
Deep-coloured, full-bodied and spicy using California's 'own' grape variety with rich meaty flavours and soft, rich tannins. **13% abv**
- 15 C** Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza Tinto, Bodegas Corral **£14.25**  
A rich, full-bodied red made in the traditional way, with at least one year of oak ageing. It has a bright raspberry and cherry fruit character and a silky smooth finish. **12.5% abv**

## Sparkling Wine

- 16 2** Hardys Stamp of Australia Chardonnay-Pinot Noir Sparkling Brut, SE Australia **£13.95**  
Crisp, with lifted citrus Chardonnay and strawberry-like Pinot Noir, soft and flavoursome with a creamy texture. **11.5% abv**

White Wine - Rated from 1 - 9.  
Number 1 being the driest  
and 9 being the sweetest.



Red Wine - Rated from A - E.  
A being the lightest and  
E being the most full-bodied.
